Vermont Beer

Trout River—Brewed & Bottled right here in Lyndonville!
Rainbow Red Draught - Whether a Kingdom native or first-time visitor, you will often hear this request: “A pint of red, please.” This is what they’re asking for. It’s a well-balanced, easy drinking American-style red ale. \$3.75

Switch Back, Burlington
Switch Back Ale— A medium colored, icy, smooth, refreshing \$3.99

Rock Art, Morrisville
Ridgerunner - A malty, lightly hopped English style ale. \$3.99
White Tail Ale - A Golden American Ale with a crisp body and slightly dry, hoppy finish. \$3.99

Long Trail, Bridgewater Corners
Long Trail Ale - This full-bodied amber ale, reminiscent of German “Alt-biers”, is the largest selling craft brew in Vermont. \$3.99

India Pale Ale - Very British, Very Hoppy. \$3.99
Double Bag - This malty, full-bodied double alt is also known as Stickebier, German slang for "secret brew." it has an alcohol content of 7.2%...! \$3.99

IPA - in the tradition of India Pale Ale’s (IPA), this copper colored ale is floral, medium bodied, with distinct hop finish. \$3.99

Dubbel — dark mahogany color with ruby hues and a complex malty taste. Hints of chocolate & nuts. \$4.50
